APPLICABILITY:

The service charges listed below are applicable to all customers served by Company and are in addition to any other charges made under Company's tariff for electric service.

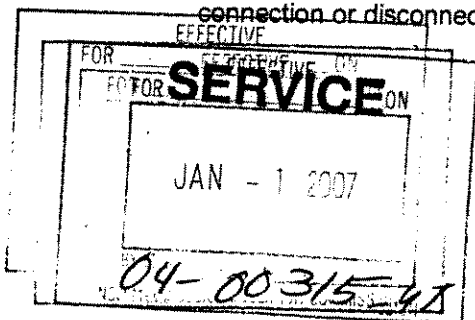
TERRITORY:

Applies to all of the Company's New Mexico service area.

SERVICE CHARGES:

- 1) Reconnection Charge: Whenever service is disconnected for non-payment charges or other reasons, a charge of \$45.00 shall be made by the Company if reconnection is made during normal Company business hours. If the Customer requests reconnection of service after normal business hours then a charge of \$65.00 shall be made by the Company for such service. In instances where a customer requests reconnection after 9 p.m. on weekdays, or at any time on weekends or holidays, PNM reserves the right to defer reconnection until the next business day.
- 2) Customer Deposit: A deposit, when required, shall not exceed an amount equivalent to one-sixth (1/6) of the customer's estimated annual billings or not more than one and one-half (1-1/2) times that customer's estimated maximum monthly bill.

Simple interest on deposits at a rate prescribed by the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission shall accrue annually to the customer's credit for the time it is held by the Company. The deposit shall cease to draw interest on the date it is returned, on the date service is terminated, or on the date the refund is sent to the customer's last known address.
- 3) Return Check or Bank Draft Charge: The Company shall apply a handling charge of \$15.00 plus state and local taxes if applicable to a customer's account balance in the event the customer's check or bank draft is returned for insufficient funds.
- 4) Late Payment Penalty: (Commercial and Industrial Customers) A one-time penalty, not to exceed five percent (5%), may be made on delinquent commercial or industrial bills. If applied, such penalty must be consistently applied within the class. This charge is not applicable to residential bills.
- 5) After Hours Connection or Disconnection Charge: If a customer requests an after hours connection or disconnection of service, a charge of \$65.00 per hour shall be made for such

special services. At the time of the request, the customer will be advised that a connection or disconnection during normal business hours will be made free of charge.

- 6) Requested Meter Test Charge: When a customer requests a meter test within a period of eighteen (18) months from a previous meter test and the meter is found to be within the accuracy standards established by the American National Standards Institute, Incorporated the Company shall charge the customer a fee of \$50.00 to test the meter.

- 7) Application Fee for QF Application for Interconnection: the application fee charged to qualifying facilities seeking to interconnect with PNM's facilities is fifty dollars (\$50.00) to all qualifying facilities with a capacity of less than 100 kW. A fee of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) will be assessed to all qualifying facilities with a capacity of 100 kW or more. Payment to PNM shall be included in the appropriate amount at the time the Application is submitted.

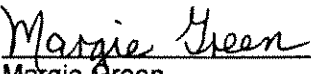
Once a qualifying facility, which has paid an application fee, interconnects with PNM, the application fee will be applied to reduce the interconnection cost to be assessed to the qualifying facility.

- 8) Tampering Charge: In cases of meter tampering, bypassing or diversion of a meter, an amount of \$200.00 shall be charged in addition to the amount due for usage and other charges as applicable. The customer shall be charged for all material and equipment necessary to repair or replace all equipment damaged due to meter tampering or bypassing or other service diversion, and other costs necessary to correct service diversion where there is no equipment damage, including incidents where service is reconnected without authority. An itemized bill of such charges must be provided to the customer.

- 9) Field Collection Charge: In cases where PNM makes a trip to the customer's premises for the purpose of attempting to collect an amount due the Company, a charge of \$8.00 will be billed to the customer's account. The Field Collection Charge does not apply if service is disconnected on the same trip subsequent to the attempt to collect the amount due the Company. The customer will not be billed for more than one Field Collection Charge in any given month.

- 10) Account Initiation Charge: An account initiation charge of \$25.00 will apply for new service or the transfer or existing service where meter installation is not required. An account initiation charge of \$50.00 will apply when meter installation is required at a new location. The account initiation charge will not apply in instances involving only a change in name where there is no change in the actual party responsible for the charges for electric service.

- 11) Meter Sockets: The meter socket required for providing electrical service to a customer's location will be provided by the customer at the customer's expense. The customer may request a meter socket from PNM, with the cost of the meter socket to be paid for by the customer. PNM's cost to the customer will include the actual cost of the meter socket plus a service fee of \$10 per meter socket. PNM will maintain a list of acceptable meter sockets and their costs for review by the customer.
- 12) Customer Internet Access to Interval Usage Data: For those customers with Interval Data Recorders and Internet Access, PNM is capable of retrieving interval data on a frequency basis and posting the data on the Internet where the customer will be given access to their usage information. PNM will supply the customer with a log-on ID and password that gives them access to a secure web site storing the interval data. Customers will be able to view interval, for example every 15 minutes, for each day. The same information can be displayed graphically in a daily load plot format. Customer interval data will be stored on the web sever for up to on year. PNM will charge monthly fee of \$20 for making such information available on the Internet. The cost for data retrieval service is a follows:

- 13) Facilities Relocation/Removal Charge: The Facilities Relocation/Removal Charge is a fee associated with relocation or removal of Company facilities at the request of the customer pursuant to the Company's Facilities Extension Policy. The Company may make a fee reflecting actual cost. Actual costs shall include direct labor costs associated with relocating or removal of Company Facilities and related indirect cost.

- 14) Temporary Facilities Charge: A fee charged to a customer when any construction is required to make the electric service connection to provide temporary service. If no facilities are required to be installed and/or removed in providing this service, then only the appropriate Account Initiation Charge will be charged. The fee schedule is as follows:

15)

A. Connect or disconnect service and read a meter already installed (includes Account Initiation Charge).	\$ 70.00
B. Install or remove single phase service and read a meter already installed (includes Account Initiation Charge).	\$240.00
C. Install and remove single phase service wires, meter and transformers (up to 50 kVA) on existing pole and read a meter (includes Account Initiation Charge)	As Calculated
D. Underground Cable By-Pass Charge applied to any customer requesting it, install temporary above ground by-pass cable in order to continue service while underground facilities are being either repaired or replaced.	As Calculated
E. All other temporary facilities – installation and removal.	As Calculated

- 16) Broken Meter Seal Charge: Fee charged any time there is an unauthorized breakage of the meter seal in two consecutive months, regardless if it is for unauthorized reconnection of service, unauthorized access in the meter enclosure, or for reasons not identifiable. Additional charges for any cost of repairs or replacement of damaged facilities, installing protective equipment, or relocation of meter will also be charged if such is required. A fee of \$15.00 may be charged by the Company.

- 17) Denial Of Access To Meter Charge: A fee charged to the customer each month when a customer denies the Company access to the Company's meter located on the customer's property. Company will estimate meter readings for that month and bill the customer for electric connection service based on the estimated readings. In addition to the service charges based on the estimated readings, the customer will be billed the Denial of Access to Meter Charge of \$25.00.
- 18) Miscellaneous Discretionary Service Charge: Fee for discretionary services not covered by the standard conditions above and provided in accordance with Commission Rules and are charged on the basis of an estimate for the job or the Company's cost plus appropriate adders.
