**SCHEDULE LGS
LARGE GENERAL SERVICE**

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APPLICABILITY:

All alternating current electric service when all service is taken through one meter at a single point of delivery.

Not available for resale, temporary, breakdown, or stand-by service.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single or three phase, 60 hertz, 120/240 volt or any available primary voltage. Service may also be furnished at 208, 480 or 2,400 volts when special arrangements are made in advance with Company. Where entire service cannot be measured at one utilization voltage with one standard type meter, it will be measured at primary voltage.

TERRITORY:

Applies to all service area of the Company in New Mexico.

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MINIMUM BILL:

1. Customer shall pay a minimum bill each month calculated on the actual demand and energy usage using the above monthly rate, but in any event, an amount that is not less than the sum of \$14.88 for each kW of the highest kW determined pursuant to Determination of Demand below, plus the tax adjustment applicable to the current month's use, if any.
2. This minimum bill shall be payable each month as calculated under paragraph 1 above during any primary term or renewal term of any contract whether customer actually establishes any demand or not, and shall be payable each month for twelve months following a month in which a demand was established or for the maximum length of time required for the amount calculated under paragraph 1 above to result in a zero minimum bill should service be discontinued on the renewal date. This amount shall be payable for this length of time whether or not (a) the contract between Company and customer has been renewed, (b) customer is in default or, (c) customer actually establishes any demand.

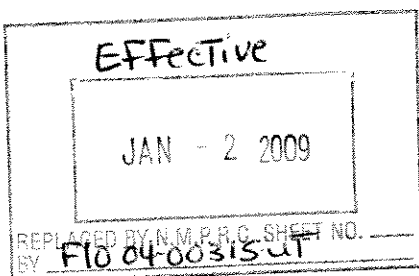
TAX ADJUSTMENT:

Billings under this schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of the taxes payable under the Gross Receipts, Franchise Fees and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of ad valorem, state and federal income taxes) payable by the utility and levied or assessed by any governmental authority on the public utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or on any object or event incidental to the rendition of the service.

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT:

For average lagging power factors of less than 80%, the measured demand will be increased according to the following formula:

$$\frac{\text{kW} \times .80}{\text{PF}}$$



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DETERMINATION OF DEMAND:

For monthly billing purposes, including calculation of the minimum bill which shall be payable whether or not there is any demand established, kW demand each month shall be the kW supplied during the 15-minute period of maximum use during the month, subject to power factor adjustments, but not less than 60% of the highest billing demand established during the months of June, July, August, or September in the 12 months ending with the current month.

PRIMARY SERVICE DISCOUNT:

If customer receives service at 12 kV or higher and customer furnishes and maintains transformers and protective devices, a primary service credit of:

Per kW of Billing Demand \$1.25 This will be applied to the customer's bill.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

This tariff schedule governs and supersedes all contracts and agreements between the Company and any of its customers served under this tariff schedule. Any service provided under this tariff schedule is further subject to the Company's rules and regulations on file with the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission. A contract may be required for extension of service under the Company's extension policy.
