**SCHEDULE OLS
OUTDOOR LIGHTING SERVICE**

APPLICABILITY:

Any customer for outdoor lighting where existing facilities have adequate capacity and suitable voltage.

Unmetered automatically controlled, overhead lighting service, operating every night from dusk to dawn. The Company will install, own, operate and maintain such lighting. Lights will be mounted on an existing service pole or poles and such service will be limited to 120-volt service. This service may be provided by various types of lighting equipment.

TERRITORY:

Applies to all service area within the New Mexico.

Additional Pole Charge

In the event customer desires a light to be installed on a pole, which will require the Company to install an additional pole, or poles, customer will be charged a distribution cost of \$1.80 per month per pole.

TAX ADJUSTMENT:

Billing under this schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of the taxes payable under the Gross Receipts. Franchise Fees and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of ad valorem, state and federal income taxes) payable by the utility and levied or assessed by any governmental authority on the public utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or on any object or event incidental to the rendition of the service.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Electric Energy Supply

The monthly kWh used by the lamps in their operation will be estimated as follows:

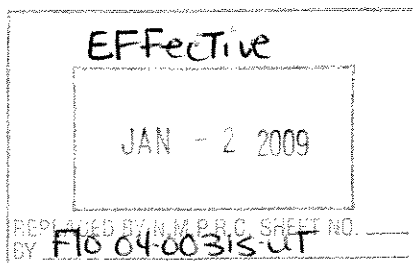
$$\frac{\text{Total Watts connected including ballast} \times 333}{1,000} = \text{kWh}$$

Type of Lamps, Glassware and Poles

All lamps, glassware and service poles shall be of a type normally used by the Company and in accordance with standards established by the Company.

Special Facilities

If customer required special facilities to be installed, the customer will make a non-refundable contribution equal to the installed cost.

Lamp Burning Hours

The Company will cause the lamps to be lighted at dusk and remain lighted until dawn, but in no event shall the total burning hours exceed 4,000 hours in any year.

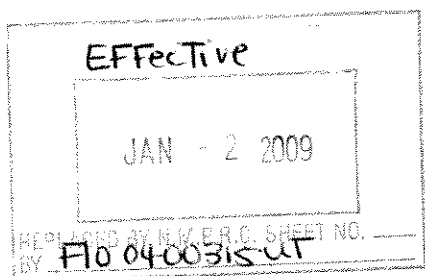
Lumens (lmn)

Lumens as used shall be the nominal rating of approximate initial lumens as rated by manufacturers.

Replacement of Lamps and Glassware

The Company will install, own, operate, and maintain the lights including lamps and glassware. Company reserves the right to remove light and appurtenances and cancel service at any time in the event more than two calls per year become necessary due to vandalism or other causes over and above regular maintenance required unless the customer agrees to pay for the additional calls and cost incurred.

This tariff schedule governs and supersedes all contracts or agreements between the Company and any of its customers served under this tariff schedule. Any service provided under this tariff schedule is further subject to the Company's rules and regulations on file with the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission. A contract may be required for extension of service under the Company's extension policy.
