

Counsel for the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority, which was not represented at that meeting, does not oppose the Motion to Amend. Counsel for NMGC asserted that prior to the mailing of this motion she was unable to reach counsel for the New Mexico Industrial Energy Consumers, which also did not participate in the July 1 meeting, to ascertain its position on this motion. The Motion to Amend is unopposed.

The Hearing Examiner **ORDERS** that:

A. The Motion to Amend is **GRANTED**.

B. The Procedural Order issued on April 25, 2008, is hereby amended as follows: Staff shall, and any Intervenors may, file direct testimony on or before August 13, 2008; any rebuttal testimony shall be filed on or before September 2, 2008; and the public hearing will commence at 9:30 A.M. on September 12, 2008 and, if necessary, continue beyond that date. All other parts of the Procedural Order issued on April 25, 2008, not changed by this Second Procedural Order, are in full force and effect.
