ORDER SCHEDULING PUBLIC COMMENT HEARING

THIS MATTER comes before the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission ("Commission" or "NMPRC") upon its own motion. The Commission finds that it is prudent to schedule a public comment hearing in this matter.

DISCUSSION

- 1. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Procedure. The Commission's Rules of Procedure permit the public to provide oral statements for the record, 1.2.2.23(F) NMAC; 1.2.2.32(A)(2) NMAC, and they provide that the Chairman may issue any procedural order to schedule a public hearing, 1.2.2.30(B)(2) NMAC.
- 2. On February 21, 2023, the Presiding Officer issued the "Notice And Order Regarding Scheduling Of Public Comment Hearing," thereby scheduling a public comment hearing to be held on March 17, 2023.
- 3. On March 17, 2023, the Commission held a public comment hearing for this Docket in which significant public comments were received and which lasted approximately five and one-half hours.

4. On July 10, 2023, the Presiding Officer issued the "Order Staying Proceedings"

which stayed this Docket pending Public Service Company of New Mexico's ("PNM")

development of cost-benefit analyses.

5. On January 16, 2024, the Presiding Officer issued an order entitled "Procedural

Schedule Supplemental Proceedings," in which the Presiding Officer resumed the proceedings in

this Docket and scheduled dates for supplemental and rebuttal testimony to be filed, and for a

public hearing to be held on April 23-24, 2024. The Presiding Officer included the opportunity for

public comment to be taken at the beginning of the public hearing.

6. The public has shown a keen interest in this Docket, evidenced by the public

comments provided on March 17, 2023, and may have a similar turnout for the second opportunity

to provide comment to give input on the supplemental proceedings.

7. The Commission's Rules of Procedure further require that reasonable "notice shall

be given to all parties of the time and place of every public hearing scheduled by the commission

or presiding officer." 1.2.2.24(C) NMAC. The Commission's Rules provide that,

The commission or presiding officer may require that public notice also be given. When public notice is required, it shall be published in a newspaper having general

circulation in the area affected by the filed pleadings at least twenty (20) days prior to the date of the public hearing, unless otherwise provided by rule, or if the commission or presiding officer finds that circumstances warrant shorter notice. The party who is required to publish notice shall cause to be filed, on or before the

date of public hearing, an affidavit of publication of a responsible officer of the newspaper making such publication. The party required by the commission or

presiding officer to publish the notice shall bear the cost of such publication.

Id. Twenty days' notice from the date of this Order would fall on April 28, 2024.

8. The Commission's last regularly scheduled open meeting prior to the public

hearing, scheduled to be conducted on April 23-24, 2024, will be held on April 18, 2024. This date

provides the best opportunity for a gathering of a quorum of the Commissioners to receive public

comment.

9. The public hearing on the supplemental proceedings in this Docket is scheduled for

two days, which is sufficient time for the Presiding Officer to receive evidence into the record and

to conduct examination of witnesses. If the public once again attends to provide significant public

comment, the public hearing in this matter is not long enough to accommodate it. Therefore, it is

necessary to separate the public comment hearing from the public hearing and to shorten the notice

period for a public comment hearing to be held after the Commission's April 18, 2024, regularly

scheduled open meeting.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

10. The public should be given the opportunity to provide comments on the

supplemental proceedings in this Docket, but circumstances warrant moving the public comment

from the public hearing to an earlier date.

11. PNM should be required to provide public notice of the public's right to provide

comments pursuant to Rule 1.2.2.24(C) NMAC.

12. Pursuant to 1.2.2.30(C) NMAC, this Order should supersede the Presiding Officer's

January 16th Order to the extent that it schedules public comment to begin on April 23, 2024.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

A. A public comment hearing shall be held on April 18, 2024, from 2:00 P.M. to 5:00

P.M., which duration may be extended at the Commission's discretion, at the Bokum Building

located at 142 W Palace. Santa Fe, NM 87505.

B. PNM shall, by April 14, 2024, at its sole expense, cause notice of the April 18th

public comment hearing to be published once in a newspaper of general circulation sufficient for

availability in every county where PNM provides service, to be emailed to PNM's customers, to

be posted on PNM's social media accounts, and to be posted on PNM's website. Publication in a

newspaper of general circulation shall be no smaller than a one-half page advertisement space.

C. Any interested persons who are not affiliated with a party in this Docket may make

oral comment in person, via the Zoom app, or by telephone. Persons making oral public comments

in person do not need to sign up in advance but do need to sign in by hand on the sign-up sheet at

142 W Palace Santa Fe, NM 87505.

D. To sign up for public comment via telephone and/or Zoom, and to receive the call-

n number and/or Zoom invite, please contact Patrick Rodriguez via email at

public.comment@prc.nm.gov or by phone at (505) 490-7910. The Commission requests, but does

not require, your registration the day before the public comment hearing. You will receive the call-

in number and Zoom invitation to join the public comment hearing by separate e-mail at some

time before noon on April 18, 2024. Please let Mr. Rodriguez know if your Zoom username is

different than the name you supply to register. If you do not know whether your Zoom username

is different than your actual name, take steps now to figure this out before you contact Mr.

Rodriguez. If you intend to appear at the public comment hearing by telephone, please provide Mr.

Rodriguez with your telephone number so that he may correlate that number to your name. Mr.

Rodriguez shall function as meeting host. If on the day of the hearing you have difficulties

connecting with Zoom or have audio/video problems, you may participate by phone; you shall,

however, contact Mr. Rodriguez that you will be participating by phone. The public comment

hearing shall be transcribed for the record, and participants shall make sure that their microphones

function properly so that the court reporter can hear you. The public comment hearing shall

commence with an introduction. After that, each commenter shall be called by name, in the order

of registration. After that time, the commenter shall exit the Zoom meeting or the host shall remove

you. These controls are imposed to ensure that the public comment hearing is conducted efficiently

and to prevent purposefully disruptive activity. If you wish to view comments, you can view the

E. Oral comments shall be limited to 3 minutes but may be shortened or extended at

the discretion of the Commission.

F. Interested persons, who are not affiliated with a party in this Docket may

additionally file written comments as allowed by Rule 1.2.2.23(F) NMAC.

and other documents filed in the public record of this Docket No. 22-00058-UT on the
