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**I. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE**

**Q. PLEASE STATE YOUR NAME, POSITION AND BUSINESS ADDRESS.**

**A.** My name is Roger Larsen. I am Manager of Marketing and Energy Efficiency Outreach for Public Service Company of New Mexico (“PNM” or the “Company”). My address is 414 Silver Avenue, SW, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87102.

**Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES AS MANAGER OF MARKETING AND ENERGY EFFICIENCY OUTREACH.**

**A.** As Manager of Marketing and Energy Efficiency Outreach, I am responsible for coordinating customer advertising including advertising consistency, messages, graphics standards and communication for PNM.

**Q. HAVE YOU PREVIOUSLY TESTIFIED IN UTILITY REGULATION PROCEEDINGS?**

**A.** Yes, I previously filed testimony in New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (“NMPRC” or “Commission”) Case No. 03-00017-UT and NMPRC Case No. 06-00210-UT, which were PNM gas rate cases, and NMPRC Case No. 07-00077-UT, NMPRC Case No. 08-00273-UT, NMPRC Case No. 10-00086-UT, and NMPRC Case No. 14-00332-UT, PNM’s most recent electric rate cases. Please see PNM Exhibit RL-1 for a summary of my education and experience.

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1 **Q. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF YOUR DIRECT TESTIMONY?**

2 **A.** The purpose of my testimony is to explain PNM's April 2014 through March  
3 2015 base period ("Base Period") customer advertising expenses. In my  
4 testimony, I will discuss:

- 5 • 17.3.350 NMAC ("Rule 350") including components of the advertising  
6 expenses that are allowable, and not allowable, for ratemaking purposes under  
7 Rule 350;
- 8 • PNM advertising and other communication expenses that are considered  
9 "Allowable Expenditures" as defined by Rule 350; and
- 10 • PNM advertising expenses that are considered "Unallowable Expenditures" as  
11 defined by Rule 350;
- 12 • The total amount of advertising Allowable Expenditures for the Base Period.

13

14 I also discuss how PNM used the allowable Base Period advertising expenses to  
15 determine the Test Year advertising expenses.

16

17 **II. BASE PERIOD CUSTOMER ADVERTISING**

18 **Q. AS A PRELIMINARY MATTER, PLEASE EXPLAIN RULE 350.**

19 **A.** Rule 350 establishes a uniform system for treating advertising expense items in  
20 setting rates for utilities regulated by the Commission. Rule 350.9 specifically  
21 addresses advertising expenses and defines those expenses which may properly be

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1 included in cost of service rates as Allowable Expenditures, and those that should  
2 not be included in cost of service rates as Unallowable Expenditures.

3  
4 Rule 350.9.B lists the kinds of expenses that are Allowable Expenditures. These  
5 expenses include communication of: (1) matters of public safety, health, and  
6 emergency situations; (2) advocacy of conservation of energy resources; (3)  
7 information explaining utility billing practices, services and rates; (4) reports that  
8 must be filed with government agencies and financial institutions; (5)  
9 employment opportunities; (6) customer or stockholder information required  
10 under state or Federal law and regulation; and (7) information that results in  
11 reduction of operating costs and more efficient utility service.

12  
13 Rule 350.9.C lists the kinds of expenses that are Unallowable Expenditures. These  
14 include expenses for advertising that: (1) promote increased usage of energy or  
15 utility services; (2) promote the sale of goods or services from any specific  
16 company except as required by law; (3) seek to establish a favorable public  
17 image; (4) advocate a position other than to provide factual information identified  
18 in Rule 350.9.B; and (5) justify a request for higher rates, the need for plant  
19 expansion, or any particular addition to plant or service costs.

20  
21 Rule 350.9.D provides that the utility has the burden of proof to demonstrate that  
22 any advertising expenses requested are Allowable Expenditures if it desires to  
23 include such expenses in determining its cost of service. Wherever appropriate in

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1 the descriptions I provide in my testimony, I have included comments  
2 demonstrating that the expenditures PNM intends to include in determining its  
3 cost of service are allowable under Rule 350.9.B.

4

5 **Q. HAVE YOU EXAMINED THE ADVERTISING EXPENSES INCURRED BY**  
6 **PNM DURING THE BASE PERIOD TO DETERMINE WHICH**  
7 **ADVERTISING EXPENSES ARE ALLOWABLE EXPENDITURES**  
8 **PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF RULE 350?**

9 **A.** Yes, I have. PNM's Base Period advertising expenses are summarized in PNM  
10 Exhibit RL-2. The Allowable Expenditures that PNM incurred during the Base  
11 Period are summarized by program and by exhibit reference. PNM Witness  
12 Monroy used Base Period Allowable Expenditures to estimate Test Period  
13 Allowable Expenditures for inclusion in the Test Period cost of service.

14

15 **Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE PNM BASE PERIOD ADVERTISING EXPENSES THAT**  
16 **ARE ALLOWABLE EXPENDITURES UNDER RULE 350.**

17 **A.** As summarized in PNM Exhibit RL-2, the total allocated Allowable Expenditures  
18 for PNM electric services that meet the criteria set forth in Rule 350.9.B in the  
19 Base Period were \$327,635. Allowable Expenditures were allocated between the  
20 PNM retail jurisdiction and FERC, as discussed by PNM Witness Monroy.

21

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1 In PNM Exhibit RL-2, the major advertising programs and their costs are  
2 summarized by amounts. These costs are detailed in PNM Exhibits RL-3 through  
3 RL-7.

4  
5 **Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE THE BASE PERIOD MARKETING AND**  
6 **ADVERTISING PROGRAMS THAT ARE ALLOWABLE EXPENDITURES**  
7 **UNDER RULE 350.**

8 **A.** PNM supports several programs that promote: (1) the safe, efficient use of  
9 electricity; (2) employment opportunities; (3) information required under state or  
10 federal law and regulation; (4) how, when, and where to contact PNM; and (5)  
11 specialized information for residential and business customers. Expenses  
12 associated with these programs are attached as PNM Exhibits RL-3 through RL-7  
13 and meet the definition of Allowable Expenditures.

14  
15 **Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE BASE PERIOD “ENERGY WORKS, BILL INSERTS”**  
16 **EXPENSES, PNM EXHIBIT RL-3.**

17 **A.** The Energy Works bill insert is distributed monthly to customers. Throughout the  
18 year the bill insert includes information about energy use, safety, and contacting  
19 PNM such as:

- 20 • How to contact PNM in different communities including hours;  
21 • Telecommunication devices for the deaf (“TDD”) and telephone typewriter  
22 (“TTY”) telephone numbers for the hearing impaired;

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- 1       • Public safety messages including outages, copper theft, and Call Before You
- 2       Dig;
- 3       • Budget Billing;
- 4       • Energy savings tips and energy efficiency programs;
- 5       • Payment options; and
- 6       • Required NMPRC information.

7

8       Sample copies of the Energy Works bill insert for the Base Period, and the  
9       PNM.com bill insert are included in PNM Exhibit RL-3. In order to determine the  
10      percentage of allowable expense for Energy Works, the allowable content area  
11      was determined for all inserts. The percentage of allowable content was then  
12      multiplied by the total cost to arrive at the total allowable cost. The total  
13      allowable cost for Energy Works is \$89,389. The calculations are included in  
14      PNM Exhibit RL-3.

15

16      Please note that the invoices in PNM Exhibit RL-3 and some other exhibits are  
17      total cost, including unallowable items. Applicable percentages (derived as  
18      described earlier) of these total invoice costs that I described earlier were used to  
19      arrive at the total allowable cost.

20

21      Expenses relating to Energy Works and other bill inserts are Allowable  
22      Expenditures because many of the messages directly relate to the requirements in  
23      Rule 350.9.B(1), (2), and (3) as outlined earlier. Regarding reasonableness,

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1 because of its content, it is appropriate that PNM customers receive Energy  
2 Works each month with their bill. Energy Works does not result in additional  
3 postage cost. The total cost is less than \$0.03 per customer per month.

4  
5 **Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE BASE PERIOD “CUSTOMER COMMUNICATIONS”**  
6 **EXPENSES, PNM EXHIBIT RL-4.**

7 **A.** This exhibit includes a variety of residential and business customer  
8 communication efforts including printed collateral material, advertising, and  
9 electronic communications. Examples include:

- 10 • PNM produces and distributes a monthly electronic newsletter, PNM Power  
11 Source, tailored for business customers. A wide variety of energy-related  
12 content is provided each month, including research reports on new products  
13 and energy management systems, and detailed information on their PNM  
14 service.
- 15 • PNM provides an automated telephone system which includes messages about  
16 safety, saving energy, bill and payment options and others.
- 17 • PNM produced information available on PNM.com about a wide range of  
18 customer options, including online payment, alerts and other program options.

19 Samples of these materials and others, and the costs, are detailed in PNM Exhibit RL-4.

20  
21 Expenses associated with Customer Communications are Allowable Expenditures  
22 because the variety of information included is consistent with Rule 350.9.B(1): it  
23 advises the safe, efficient use of electricity; (2) advocates conservation of energy

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1 resources; (3) explains utility billing practices, services and rates; and (4) provides  
2 information that results in reduction of operating costs and more efficient utility  
3 service. Regarding reasonableness, costs to produce the electronic newsletter were  
4 reduced by contracting with a company that produces electronic newsletters for  
5 several other companies. Their economies of scale made it cheaper than  
6 producing and emailing the newsletter locally. Advertising is produced by local  
7 advertising agencies, and the costs to produce the advertising are relatively  
8 modest and efficient. The media to run advertising is intended to reach as many  
9 customers as possible with as little expense as possible. Further, many collateral  
10 materials are produced in-house, further reducing the total cost.

11

12 The total Base Period allowable expenses for PNM Customer Communications  
13 are \$33,501. Copies of invoices and materials are included in PNM Exhibit RL-4.  
14 PNM energy efficiency program advertising expenses were not included in this  
15 case.

16

17 **Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE BASE PERIOD “INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER**  
18 **STATE OR FEDERAL LAW AND REGULATION” EXPENSES, PNM**  
19 **EXHIBIT RL-5.**

20 **A.** There are several documents that PNM must produce to satisfy the needs of  
21 government agencies and financial institutions, including proxy materials to  
22 investors and stockbrokers who then pass the materials on to their customers.  
23 PNM does not have access to stockbrokers’ customer lists. Further, the Securities

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1 and Exchange Commission requires PNM to disclose any material investor  
2 information via a news wire service. The total Base Period allowable expense is  
3 \$178,887, as detailed in PNM Exhibit RL-5, which also contains representative  
4 samples of these communications.

5  
6 Expenses associated with producing required advertising are Allowable  
7 Expenditures because these documents are consistent with Rule 350.9.B(4), and  
8 (6): reports that must be filed with government agencies or financial institutions,  
9 and customer or stockholder information required under state or federal law and  
10 regulation. Regarding reasonableness, the formats of the documents are consistent  
11 with regulatory requirements, industry standards and market expectations.

12 Examples include:

- 13 • News releases;
- 14 • Annual meeting proxy distribution;
- 15 • Periodic webcast communications with the investment community; and
- 16 • Reproduction costs for required SEC documents.

17  
18 **Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE BASE PERIOD “LOW INCOME AND SENIOR  
19 COMMUNICATIONS” EXPENSES, PNM EXHIBIT RL-6.**

20 **A.** PNM places special importance on helping low income and senior customers. For  
21 more than 30 years, PNM has offered the PNM Good Neighbor Fund to help  
22 customers who need assistance paying their electric bill. PNM provides  
23 advertising and events to help low income customers apply for financial

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1 assistance and to help them pay for their energy bills. During the Base Period, 33  
2 low income events were held in communities across the PNM service territory.  
3 Thousands of customers attended the events to apply for financial assistance and  
4 to get advice on lowering their energy bills with PNM energy efficiency  
5 programs. Informational fliers and Spanish and English low income brochures  
6 were also produced to help explain PNM programs and to help communicate how  
7 customers can save money on energy costs.

8  
9 Expenses associated with low income and senior customer events, materials and  
10 communications are Allowable Expenditures because they meet the requirements  
11 of Rule 350.9.B(1): it advises regarding public safety, health, and emergency  
12 situations; (2) advocates conservation of energy resources; and (3) provides  
13 information explaining utility billing practices, services and rates. Regarding  
14 reasonableness, the vast majority of these communication materials were  
15 produced in-house at PNM. In addition, PNM employees and other low income  
16 agencies staffed the events at no incremental cost. As a result, the costs incurred  
17 for these low income customer programs were reasonable.

18  
19 The total Base Period allowable expense is \$21,723. Copies of sample invoices  
20 and materials are included in PNM Exhibit RL-6.

21

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1 **Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE BASE PERIOD “EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES”**  
2 **EXPENSES, PNM EXHIBIT RL-7.**

3 **A.** PNM periodically advertises employment opportunities. Expenses associated with  
4 notification of employment opportunities are Allowable Expenditures because  
5 they are consistent with Rule 350.9.B(5). All of the claimed expenses were direct  
6 charges for employment vacancies, and therefore are reasonable costs. The total  
7 Base Period allowable expense is \$4,136, as detailed in PNM Exhibit RL-7,  
8 which includes sample invoicing materials and employment advertisements.

9

10 **Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE BASE PERIOD PNM ADVERTISING EXPENSES THAT**  
11 **ARE NOT RECOVERABLE EXPENDITURES UNDER NMPRC RULE 350.**

12 **A.** During the Base Period, PNM had approximately \$682,862 in advertising  
13 expenses that cannot be recovered under Rule 350.9B. Examples of advertising  
14 that was excluded from Base Period cost of service are:

- 15 • A television commercial letting customers know about solar facilities that  
16 PNM is building.
- 17 • Employment advertising that appeared on websites or out-of-state  
18 publications.
- 19 • Various sponsorship ads and social media ads whose message contents did not  
20 meet the qualifications of Rule 350.9.B.

21

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1                   **III. TEST PERIOD ADVERTISING EXPENSES**

2   **Q. HOW DID PNM DETERMINE ITS ALLOWABLE TEST PERIOD**  
3   **ADVERTISING EXPENSES?**

4   **A.** To arrive at an estimate of its Test Period advertising expenses, PNM first  
5   identified the allowable and non-allowable advertising expenses during the Base  
6   Period. PNM then applied an annual 1.5% escalation rate to the allowable Base  
7   Period advertising expenses to determine the allowable Test Year advertising  
8   expenses, as described in the testimony of PNM Witness Monroy. I believe the  
9   use of an annual 1.5% escalator is reasonable considering recent experience with  
10  increases in the cost of allowable advertising.

11

12   **Q. WHAT IS YOUR OVERALL CONCLUSION REGARDING THE AMOUNT**  
13   **OF ALLOWABLE ADVERTISING EXPENSES THAT ARE INCLUDED IN**  
14   **THE TEST PERIOD?**

15   **A.** The allowable advertising expenditures in the amount of \$327,635 included in the  
16   Test Period represent a reasonable level of advertising expense given PNM's  
17   obligations to communicate various kinds of information under state and federal  
18   law and in furtherance of responsibility to provide safe and adequate service to its  
19   customers. My opinion is based on a review of allowable advertising expenditures  
20   during the Base Period and previous years and my knowledge of the efforts PNM  
21   makes to control advertising costs. This confirms my opinion that PNM's

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1 estimate of Test Period allowable advertising expense is reasonable and consistent  
2 with advertising spending over time.

3

4 **Q. DOES THIS CONCLUDE YOUR DIRECT TESTIMONY?**

5 **A.** Yes.

Whether you are building a deck, installing a mailbox or planting a tree, do not assume your project's size doesn't have the possibility of affecting underground utilities on your property.

Don't dig within 18 inches of the lines with mechanical equipment such as trenchers and augers. If you must cross utility lines, carefully uncover the area so you can see and not damage the utility lines.

After you call 811, PNM has two business days to mark electric lines.

# Copper Theft Puts You and Your Children at Risk

Copper theft presents a serious public safety hazard. Call us at 888-DIAL-PNM (888-342-5766) immediately if you see these:

- Thieves leave transformers open (the green boxes that house electrical equipment) that hold live wires. Touching them could be deadly. Stay away, keep others away and tell your children not to touch these boxes. Unless you report an open transformer, we may not know it's out there. So call if you see one!

- After a copper theft, business owners may find their power is on but fluctuating, electronics are sparking, or see arcing around the meter box or transformer. Don't touch anything! Call us.

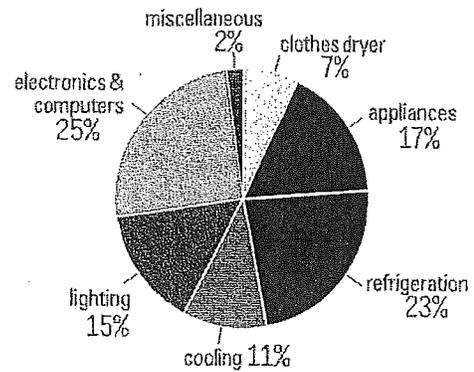
