EGRESS FROM THE CUSTOMERS PREMISES



An identified representative of the Company shall have the right of ingress and egress to and from the Customer's premises and the Company's equipment for the purpose of inspecting, maintaining, testing, reading, installing, removing, or changing its meters, wires, and equipment. Generally, ingress and egress shall be provided for on the Customer's own property. If the pathway of egress and ingress must go through the property of another, then it is the Customer's responsibility to obtain right-of-way or permanent easement for this purpose.

The Company will assist the Customer in securing rights-of-way necessary for line extensions, if requested. The Customer shall pay the Company for such assistance.
