- Applications may only be from 501(c) 3 nonprofits.

Types of Energy Efficiency Projects Funded

Core Energy Efficiency Projects

- Energy efficient lighting upgrades
- Energy efficient windows
- Purchase of Energy Star appliances
- Solar (Solatubes, PV)

Additional Energy Efficiency Project

- * These types of project proposals should have a clear, concise and compelling case. This should include the age or condition of items being replaced and the energy efficient results the upgrades would create.
 - Building insulation and weatherization
 - Server or computer energy efficient component upgrades

Grant Proposal Overview

- 1. Provide a brief overview of the proposed project and state the project goals. Clearly state for what type of project you are seeking funding for.
- 2. Describe the need the grant funds will be used to address and how the project will increase energy efficiency. Include any methods you will use to quantify energy savings.
- 3. State if you are also seeking energy savings assistance through the PNM Quick Saver program.

PNM Quick Saver is one of a suite of programs that help nonprofit business customers save energy and money. Eligible projects for PNM Quick Saver include: refrigeration components, lighting fixtures and lamps and lighting control upgrades. Nonprofit customers who participate in this program must use less than 100 kilowatts a month. See www.pnm.com/bizrebates for more information. *Participation in PNM Quick Saver is not a requirement of the Reduce Your Use grant program.

- 4. Describe how you will measure and evaluate your project.
- 5. Identify any PNM employee or retirees who are involved with your organization and explain their roles.
- 6. Describe how you will recognize the PNM Fund. This could include traditional and social media, newsletters, email or special events.
- 7. Provide a proposed project budget. List each item you are requesting funding for by individual cost and total project cost. You will be able to attach a contractor's quote at the end of the application process.

Who Cannot Apply?

- Sectarian or religious programs for religious purposes
- Veterans, labor and political organizations or campaigns
- Organizations outside of PNM's service territories
- Organizations that are not registered with the appropriate state registration agency (New Mexico Attorney General, IRS) or are not in good standing with the registration body
- Organizations that limit membership and services based on race, religion, color, creed, sex, sexual orientation, age or national origin
- Organizations without current or active IRS 501(c)(3) status
