### **PNM Good Neighbor Fund Eligibility Guidelines**

Through the **Good Neighbor Fund**, PNM customers who are experiencing an emergency financial situation that has caused a sudden drop or loss of household income and who are income eligible can get help to pay part or all of a past-due electric bill. This situation must have occurred within the last six months.

 Paperwork is required showing proof of the emergency condition that caused a sudden drop or loss of income in the home
