NOTICE OF FILING

NOTICE is given of the filing of an Application by Public Service Company of New Mexico (“PNM”) with the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (“Commission”) on March 23, 2020, requesting approvals and authorizations: (1) to issue new senior unsecured notes (“SUNs”) in an amount up to \$200 million (the “Proposed New SUNs”) to repay short-term debt incurred to support PNM’s utility operations and utility construction program to provide service to PNM’s customers, and (2) for all other approvals and authorizations as may be required for PNM to effectuate the execution, delivery and performance of the proposed issuance of long term debt.

1. The Commission is required by law to act promptly on PNM’s Application.

2. A public hearing in this case shall be held on April 15, 2020, commencing at 9:00 a.m. MST at the Commission’s offices in the P.E.R.A. Building, 1120 Paseo de Peralta, Santa Fe, New Mexico, ground floor board room, for the purpose of hearing and receiving testimony, exhibits, arguments and any other appropriate matters relevant to this proceeding. Such hearing may be vacated if deemed not required pursuant to

17.1.2.8(C)(3) NMAC, in which case the Commission will take public comment and dispose of the Application at an Open Meeting.

3. Interested persons desiring to intervene in the proceeding must file a Motion to Intervene under Subsections A and B of 1.2.2.23 NMAC on or before April 8, 2020.

4. Any interested person may appear at the time and place of hearing (or the Commission Open Meeting if the hearing is vacated) and make written or oral comment without becoming an intervenor. Interested persons may also send written comments, which shall reference Case No. 20-00071-UT, to the Commission at P.O. Box 1269, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504-1269. Comments shall not be considered as evidence..

5. Interested persons may inspect PNM's Application filed in this case, together with any exhibits and related papers, online at <http://www.pnm.com/regulatory> or <http://nmprc.state.nm.us> under "Case Lookup EdoCKET," This case has been docketed as Case No. 20-00071-UT and any inquiries should refer to that number.

6. The Commission's Rule for Utility Applications, 17.1.2 NMAC, applies to this case, except as modified by Order of the Commission or the Hearing Examiner. A copy of this Rule is available online at <http://164.64.110.134/nmac/home>.

8. On or before April 8, 2020, the Commission's Utility Division Staff shall, and Intervenors may, file Direct Testimony regarding this case. Staff shall state in its Direct Testimony whether it believes a hearing is necessary.

9. Any Rebuttal Testimony shall be filed by April 10, 2020.
10. Anyone filing pleadings, documents or testimony in this case will serve copies on all parties of record and the Commission's Utility Division Staff.
11. Interested persons should contact the Commission at 505-827-6956 for confirmation of the hearing date, time, and place since hearings are occasionally rescheduled or canceled if deemed not required at the discretion of the Hearing Examiner or Commission.
