**ERRATA ORDER**

**THIS MATTER** comes before the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (“Commission” or “NMPRC”) on the August 10, 2018 Application of Public Service Company of New Mexico (PNM or “Applicant”), seeking site location approval and for right-of-way (“ROW”) width determination for a 345 kV transmission line and associated facilities. The Commission, having reviewed the Application and being otherwise duly informed, **FINDS:**

1. On August 22, 2018, the Commission issued an Order in this matter which required PNM issue Notice of this proceeding at the earliest possible date but by no later September 6, 2018; and the Notice shall indicate that the sixty (60) day November 5, 2018 deadline shall apply to filing of protests and motions to intervene.

2. The August 22<sup>nd</sup> Order contained Errata regarding the dates for filing direct and rebuttal testimony by Staff and intervenors. For this reason, the August 22<sup>nd</sup> Order Decretal Paragraphs. should be revised as follows.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

A. **Decretal Paragraph C. shall be amended to read that Staff and Intervenor testimony shall be timely if filed on or before November 5, 2018 and Staff and Intervenor Rebuttal testimony shall be timely if filed on or before November 12, 2018.**

B. **Decretal Paragraph G. is hereby added to read: “All procedural dates and requirements of this case are subject to further order of the Commission and any persons**

**interested in attending the hearing must monitor the Commission's e-docket case filing system and website or contact the Commission for confirmation of the hearing date, time, and place, since procedural orders and hearings are occasionally changed or rescheduled."**

C. This Order is being issued pursuant to 1.2.2.30(B) NMAC by the Commission Chairman or by any other single Commissioner.
