



NOTICE TO PNM CUSTOMERS

Public Service Company of New Mexico (PNM) filed its first annual grid modernization reconciliation filing with the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission on March 2, 2026 (PRC Case No. 26-00000___). The filing presents PNM’s actual costs for year one of its Grid Modernization plan approved in Case No. 22-00058-UT, and proposes a rider to go into effect on April 15, 2026, to recover those costs. PNM’s filing includes bill impacts of the proposed rider by rate class. PRC proceedings have begun to address the requests in PNM’s application.

PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing, if required, will be held beginning at 9:00 a.m. on _____, 2026, to hear and receive testimony, exhibits, and legal arguments about PNM’s application. If you wish to participate in the hearing as a party to this case you must file a motion for leave to intervene, pursuant to 1.2.2.23 NMAC on or before _____, 2026. Anyone filing pleadings, documents or testimony in this case will serve a copy on all parties and the Commission Staff. Filings must also be sent to hearing examiner _____ at _____@[prc.nm.gov](https://www.prc.nm.gov). The Commission’s Rules of Procedure, found at 1.2.2 NMAC,

shall apply to this case except as modified by Order of the Commission or Hearing Examiner. The rules of procedure and other NMPRC rules are available online at the New Mexico Compilation Commission at <https://nmonesource.com/nmos/en/nav.do>.

Anyone filing pleadings, documents, or testimony in this case shall comply with the Commission's electronic filing policy. Filings must be in PDF format and be Optical Character Recognition ("OCR") enabled. Filings must include an electronic signature and be sent to the Record Management Bureau's email address, prc.records@prc.nm.gov, within regular business hours (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. MT) of the due date in order to be considered timely filed. Anyone whose testimony is filed in this case must attend the public hearing and submit to examination under oath unless otherwise determined by the hearing examiners.

PUBLIC COMMENT

If you are interested in the case but do not wish to become a party, you may make written and oral comments as allowed by Rule 1.2.2.23(F) NMAC. Public comments are not taken at the evidentiary hearing because they are not evidence, but they are reviewed and considered by Commission staff. You may send written comments before the Commission takes final action by sending the comment, which must specifically reference Case No. 26-00000 ___, to prc.records@prc.nm.gov, or Commission Records Management Bureau, 142 West Palace Ave. #300, Santa Fe, NM 87501. The Commission may be reached by telephone at 1-888-427-5772 if there are questions about how to submit written comments. Additionally, oral comments may be taken at public comment hearing if one is scheduled by the Commission. If a public comment hearing is scheduled the date, time and location will be provided. Public comment is also welcome during Commission open meetings. The open meetings schedule is available on the Commission website.
