**UNOPPOSED MOTION OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF NEW MEXICO  
TO AMEND ITS APPLICATION AND SUPPORTING TESTIMONY AND EXHIBITS**

Public Service Company of New Mexico (“PNM”), pursuant to 1.2.2.10 NMAC and the *Order Further Extending Stay* issued on February 27, 2026, hereby request the Commission grant PNM leave to amend its Application and supporting testimony and exhibits. In support of this request, PNM states as follows:

1. On October 31, 2025, PNM filed its Application to Terminate PNM’s Sky Blue Voluntary Renewable Energy Program (“Sky Blue”) pursuant to the Commission’s Final Order in Case No. 21-00158-UT, which proposed a termination date in mid-2026.
2. On December 29, 2025, ARRAY filed its Statement of Contested Issues, which requested this matter should be dismissed.
3. On December 31, 2025, PNM and ARRAY filed an Unopposed Joint Motion to Stay the Procedural Schedule, providing time for PNM and ARRAY to resolve ARRAY’s objection to the termination of PNM Sky Blue.

4. PNM and ARRAY filed joint status reports on January 30, 2026, and February 27, 2026. The second joint status report stated: “ARRAY has indicated it would like to continue its participation in Sky Blue until the end of 2026, but does not oppose PNM seeking to terminate the program at the end of 2026 (December 31, 2026). PNM is agreeable to pushing back the proposed termination date accordingly.”<sup>1</sup>

5. On February 27, 2026, the Hearing Examiner issued the Order Further Extending Stay, stating that “PNM informs that it intends to file a motion to amend its original application with a proposed termination date no earlier than December 31, 2026, and upon the granting of PNM’s motion, ARRAY intends to file a motion to withdraw its Statement of Contested Issues.”<sup>2</sup>

6. The Amended Application filed concurrently with this Motion is essentially the same as the original Application filed on October 31, 2025, with the exception of the proposed termination date.

7. PNM circulated this motion to the other parties to this proceeding; their positions are as follows: ARRAY supports the motion. Staff does not oppose. No other party responded.

**WHEREFORE,**

For the reasons stated above, the Joint Movants respectfully request that the Commission:

- 1) Grant PNM leave to amend its application and supporting testimony and exhibits; and
- 2) Conduct a second prehearing conference and restart the proceeding in light of the amended termination date.
