TRANSPORTATION ELECTRIFICATION PROGRAM

Page 1 of 2

APPLICABILITY: The Transportation Electrification Program (“TEP”) rider will apply to all non-lighting retail customer classes.

TERRITORY: All territory served by the Company in New Mexico.

DESCRIPTION: This rider collects Commission-approved expenses that were incurred during the previous calendar year for PNM’s Transportation Electrification Program.

TEP RATE: The monthly TEP rate is a \$/kWh bill charge that does not vary with seasons.

ANNUAL TEP ADJUSTMENT: PNM will make an annual filing with the Commission by the last day in February, accompanied by an Advice Notice and supporting testimony, to adjust the TEP rate for the upcoming twelve (12) months. The annual TEP rate adjustment will go into effect with the first billing cycle in May. The TEP rider surcharge shall not exceed \$25,000 per 12-month period. X

DURATION OF THE RIDER: This rider shall be in effect until replaced or canceled by the Commission.

RULES AND REGULATIONS: In addition to the TEP rate described in this rider, all specifics of service and monthly charges for electric service under the customer's regular rate schedule apply. Where they are not inconsistent with this rider, the Company's Rules and Regulations are a part of this rider as if fully written herein.
