PNM bill help available on August 1 in Albuquerque

(Albuquerque, NM) – Low-income customers with a past-due bill or disconnect notice on their PNM bill, as well as seniors (60+) who qualify for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) or the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), can receive help with a portion of their PNM electric bill on Friday, Aug. 1.

PNM will be providing bill help from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. at Los Griegos Health & Social Service Center located at 1231 Candelaria Rd. NW Albuquerque, NM 87107.

During this time, PNM will provide bill assistance through the PNM Good Neighbor Fund to eligible customers, energy efficiency tips and resources to help reduce energy costs, and information for upcoming financial literacy courses to help manage finances.

Customers should bring their past-due PNM bill or disconnect notice, proof of participation in LIHEAP or SNAP for the current year, and a valid ID matching the name on the PNM account. Seniors are eligible even without a past-due balance or disconnect notice, as long as they meet income qualifications.
